12.1 FLAG CONVENTIONS

12.2 REGATTA SCORING

US Sailing Racing Rules RRSA4 and 90.3 Scoring shall apply with the following Modifications:

When boats sail more than one race for any regatta, the scores of all races sailed will be combined to determine the boats regatta score. No race will be excluded.

The number of boats participating will be used as the number of starters even if this number exceeds the number of boats participating in any single race. The boats that sail, but do not sail in all races of a regatta, will be scored as DNS for the races they did not sail.

When more than one race is sailed in a regatta ties will be resolved per the following sequence.

1. The boat with the most 1st, most 2nd, most 3rd, etc.
2. The boat with the lowest total corrected time for the regatta's races.
3. The boat with the best corrected position in the last race.

One boat in a **class** finishing within the time limit **qualifies the race for all boats in that class.**

One boat in a **division** finishing within the time limit **qualifies that race for all boats in that division** even if the time limit has expired for one or more classes within that division. A division's time limit does not expire until the time limits for all classes that division have expired. **However, if all classes in a division do not share the same Start/Finish then the time limit for the division expires when any class time limit expires.**

12.3 GUEST BOATS – Non-registered Boats

Guest boats are those boats invited by the host club sponsoring the regatta that are not registered with DRYA and have not paid the required DRYA race fees.

Guest boats will be scored for the regatta and be eligible to receive awards for that regatta.

Guest boats will be eliminated and WILL NOT be scored for season awards and will not be eligible for season awards.

13.1 SERIES FOR WHICH TROPHIES OR FLAGS WILL BE AWARDED

There will be a Spring and Summer Series, and/or a Fixed (Point-to-Point) and Windward/Leeward Series. There will also be a Season Overall Series.

Regattas counted in these Series will be those which are sailed on Lake St. Clair sponsored by DRYA member Clubs which use the standard class splits.

Individual clubs may add additional classes for their regatta. The results of these classes will not count in the Series results.

Recognition of all DRYA series winners will be made at the DRYA Annual Awards presentation.

13.2 AWARDS

First, second, and third place awards will be given in each series for each class with a designated start in that series. Boats are required to sail the minimum required number of races to be eligible for season awards. See Section 13.6 - Required Races

Guest boats will not be scored for series awards. See Section 12.3 - Guest Boats

13.3 SCORING

Scoring shall be according to US Sailing Appendix A – Scoring
See Section 13.6 – Required Races for number of races required to qualify.

Boats not racing shall not be scored.

For all classes corrected times will be calculated using TIME ON TIME (TOT). The TOT formula is $650 / (\text{DRYA PHRF rating} + 557)$ calculated to hh:mm:ss.00

All boats are simultaneously racing in at least two races, the class race and the division race. In some regattas boats may also be racing in additional races; i.e. best JAM, best club, best team, or some other special race. These races will be calculated as above on an average time per mile basis.

13.4 DRYA SERIES SCORING

The SPRING SERIES consists of the scheduled regattas sailed before the BYC Mackinaw Race.

The SUMMER SERIES consists of the scheduled regattas sailed after the Spring Series.

The SEASON OVERALL SERIES consists of all the races sailed.

13.5 DRYA DIVISION SCORING

The DRYA Classes will be divided into divisions for the purpose of awarding overall trophies. These divisions are:

PHRF – All classes with PHRF or PRF as part of the class name.

OFFSHORE ONE DESIGN – One design boats assigned to the A/B Course in the STANDARD DRYA Sailing Instructions.

SMALL BOAT ONE DESIGN – One design boats assigned to the C Course in the STANDARD DRYA Sailing Instructions.

Classes in the same division often sail in races of different lengths, therefore corrected times for division places will be calculated on an average time per mile per race basis

13.6 REQUIRED RACES

Boats are required to sail a minimum number of races to qualify for all awards. This number may be different for the various classes and divisions.

The number of races required is shown in the following table.

A boat may not exclude a regatta in which it scores a DSQ or DNE.

13.7 DRYA SEASON TROPHIES

As permanent custodian of various trophies, the DRYA presents these trophies for the DRYA Season Championships, as dictated by the Standard Deed of Gift, as determined by the Individual Deed of Gift, or as requested by the class awarding the trophy.

The Standard Deed of Gift for trophies means the best score in all regularly scheduled DRYA races sailed in Lake St. Clair for which there is no added entry fee and a required number of races must be sailed. Races scored TLE (Time limit expired) or ABN (abandoned) will not be included.

Conditions for awarding Division Trophies

Winner shall be determined from among the classes competing in their division. Classes are assigned to a division at the beginning of the season before the first race.

The same scoring system as used to determine each of the season class winners shall be used to determine the division winners. All boats eligible in the division will be scored first through the number sailing in that regatta.

ABN (abandoned race): If the race for any class in the division is abandoned, the race will not be scored for that division awards.

TLE (time limit expired): Refer to SECTION 12.2 – REGATTA SCORING

If a class **elects not to sail** in a race or regatta, that race or regatta shall still count in that class’s division results.

13.8 DRYA SPECIAL TROPHIES

These trophies are presented as requested by the class or association awarding the trophy or by the Individual Deed of Gift.
